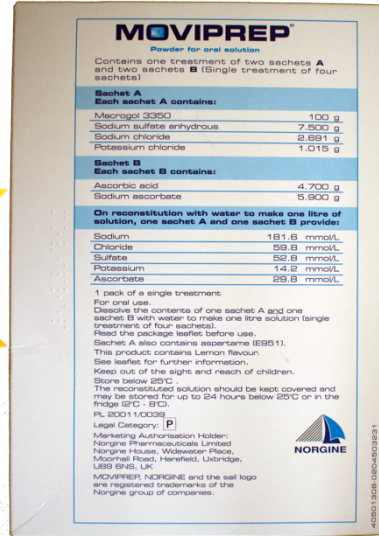
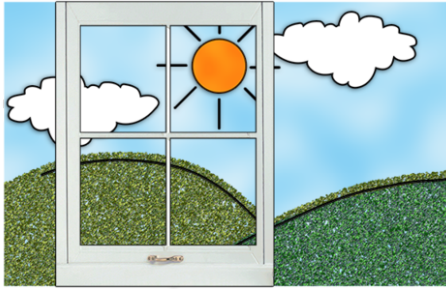


Taking Moviprep if your colonoscopy is in the afternoon



A: What is Moviprep



Moviprep is a drink that helps to clear your body of all its poo.



You must take your Moviprep before your colonoscopy exam.



A colonoscopy exam is where a camera goes up your bottom to check how healthy your bowel is.

B: What you need to do **SEVEN DAYS** before you take your Moviprep



FOLLOW the low residue diet. Your easy read guide tells you about the low residue diet.



YOU MUST stop **any iron tablets** or multi-vitamins with iron **seven days before** your colonoscopy exam.



Senna tablets help you to go for a poo.



If you go to the toilet for a poo only once, twice or three times a week you must take Senna tablets.



Start taking **two Senna tablets** each night, **3 days before** you take the Moviprep.



You should also take another 6 Senna tablets, in one go, **4 hours before taking Moviprep.**



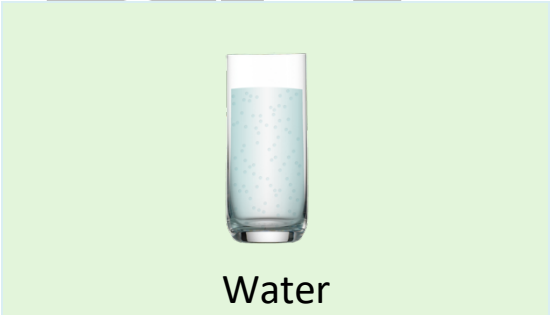
You could look at the date of your appointment and make a timetable of what you need to in the week before your appointment.

C: The day before your Colonoscopy examination



You can have a light lunch up to **1pm.**

If you are hungry **after 1 pm** you can only have clear liquid:





Oxo / Bovril



diluted juice



Fruit juice WITHOUT BITS

TAKE YOUR USUAL MEDICATION 1 HOUR BEFORE AND 1 HOUR AFTER YOU TAKE YOUR MOVIPREP

How to take your Moviprep



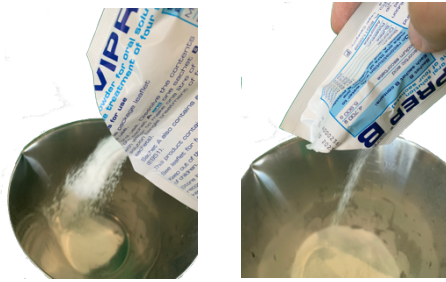
Take your first dose of Moviprep at 7 pm. Remember it is the day before the test.



1: Each box of Moviprep contains two sealed plastic bags.



2: Open **one** of the sealed bags and take out sachet A and sachet B.



3: Pour sachet A and sachet B into the same jug.



4: Add 1 litre of water to the jug.



5: Stir until all the water becomes clear. This could take up to 5 minutes.



6: Drink one glassful of Moviprep every 15-30 minutes until you have drunk it all (over about 1-2 hours)



7: You must also drink ½ a litre of water or a clear drink.

D: The day of the examination



Take the second dose of Moviprep at 6am on the day of the test.



Make up and drink your second litre of Moviprep (sachets A and B) over the next 1-2 hours. Follow the instructions from 1 to 6 again.



You will need to drink another $\frac{1}{2}$ a litre of water or a clear drink.

After finishing your Moviprep allow two hours for it to clear you of any poo. Then you can leave for your appointment.



Stop drinking 2 hours before your appointment.
